





Creating Turnitin assignments

<p>1. Click on the Control Panel.</p>	
<p>2. Go to the content area you wish to place the assignment in (e.g. Course Documents, Course Materials).</p>	
<p>3. In the upper right side of the screen, select Turnitin Assignment from the drop down box. Click Go.</p>	
<p>4. On the next screen you will be able to create a new paper or revision assignment, list the assignment title, point value, and set the dates.</p>	

5. Set the Start, Due, and Post Dates (the post date must occur on or after the due date).
