

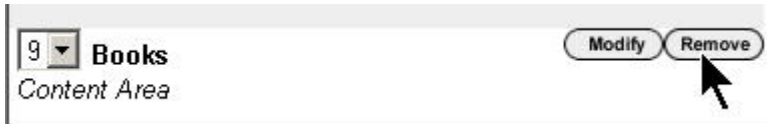
Removing Course Content

This tutorial explains how to remove a content area from your course. Be sure to save any documents you want to keep before removing this content area.

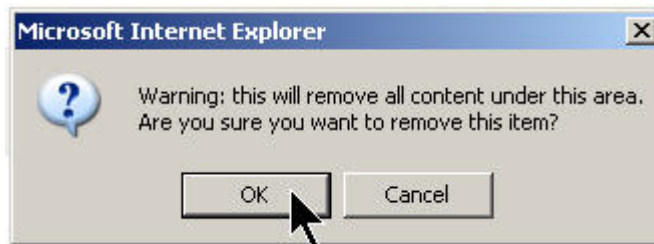
- 1 Select **Manage Course Menu** from the **Course Options** area.



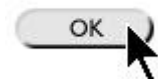
- 2 Select the content area you would like to remove. Click on the **Remove** button.



- 3 A warning message appears when you select **Remove**. Click **OK** to continue.



- 4 Click **OK** to continue.



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- 5 Select your course from the top navigation menu to view the changes.
